

On behalf of the York County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA), we invite you to become a member of our Pewter Paws Society. The Society recognizes those individuals or groups who have accepted the challenge of providing for the on-going financial requirements of the York County SPCA.

Membership in the Pewter Paw Society is accorded to anyone who makes a monetary donation to the York County SPCA of \$2500 or more. Some groups have undertaken fundraising activities and have accumulated that amount over several years; members have up to 5 years to accumulate the donation amount. Members include those who contribute to the York County SPCA in their bequests or other estate planning, gifts of real estate or insurance proceeds, or cash. Each gift plays a vital role in underwriting the work of the SPCA in its efforts to find a home for every lost or abandoned animal in the County.

Membership is recognized by the placement of a permanent engraved paw on the lobby wall (The Paws of Fame) of the Brougher Companion Animal Shelter. These paws use our distinctive logo and are cast by skilled York County pewter craftsmen. Additionally, Pewter Paw Society members are listed in our *Pet Gazette* as a way to provide an example to others who may want to remember the SPCA in their gift planning.

In addition to furthering the goals of the York County SPCA, donors may receive a variety of tax benefits and annual income benefits from making a planned contribution to the York County SPCA.
